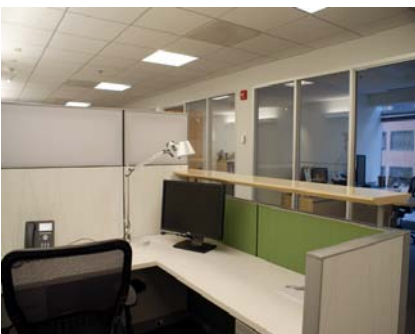
Interplan has recently completed a new 12,500 RSF space for Neustar, Incorporated, located in downtown Washington, DC.
